Guidelines for M. Phil. Dissertation Submission

Prior to submission of the Dissertation, the students shall make a pre-M. Phil. 1. Presentation in the Department that may be open to all faculty members and research students, for getting feedback and comments, which may be suitably incorporated into the draft dissertation under the advice of the supervisor.

The candidate would be required to adhere to the following for Submission 2. of M. Phil. Dissertation:

- NOC (No Objection Certificate) from D.U. Computer Centre and Central Science (i) Library.
- Original Identity Card issued by the Department of Statistics. (ii)
- Certificate of pre-M. Phil. Presentation signed by Supervisor and Head of the (iii) Department. (Blank certificate may be obtained from office of the Department).
- Three Copies of Dissertation- Soft Bound (Spiral Binding not allowed). (iv)
 - 2 sides printing/photocopying of the Body of the Dissertation
 - Preferred: Typing 12 point font size
 - * Preferred: Printing either in Times New Roman or Arial font
 - * Preferred: Spacing 1.5
 - Margins:
- Left: 1.5 inches Right: 1.0 inche
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 - Bottom: 1.25 inches
- (v) 1 CD- (Complete Dissertation in PDF Format)
- 3. Application for submission of dissertation (may be obtained from office of the Department) forwarded by the Supervisor.
- 4. Receipt for submission of M. Phil. Part-II Fee.
